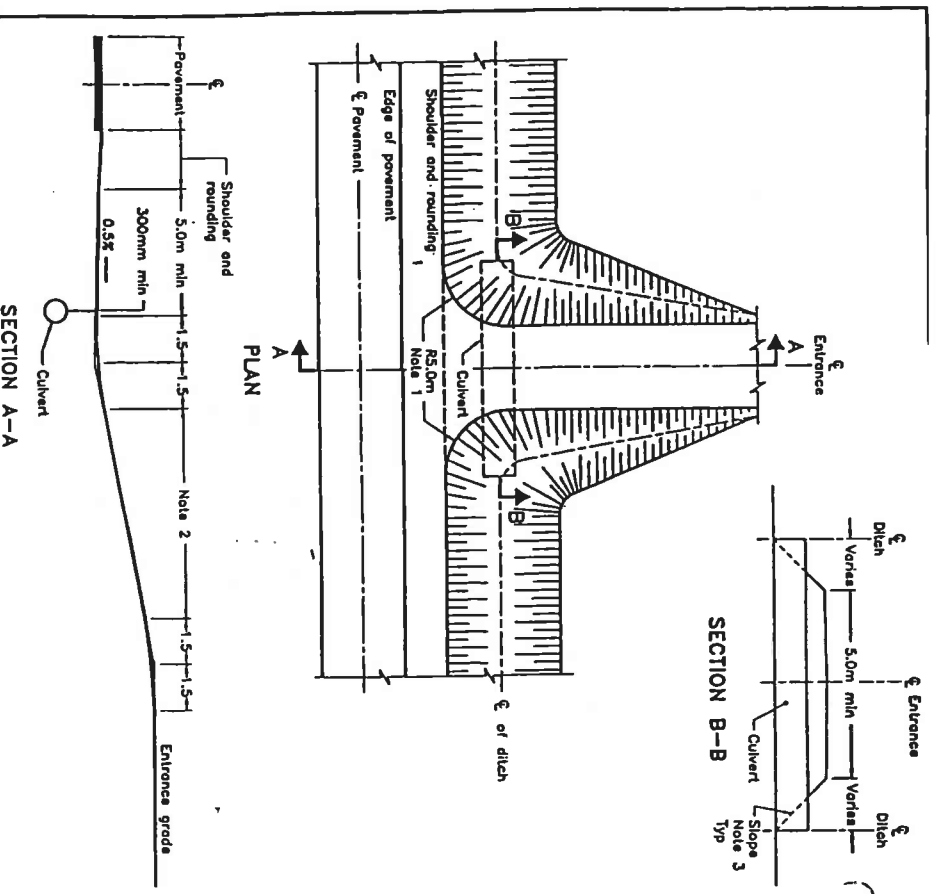

A public entranceway is an entrance opening onto a Municipal Road from a public road, street or highway or other thoroughfare maintained by a municipal or other authority.

A residential entranceway is an entrance opening onto a Municipal Road from a private residence or from a multi-family dwelling containing not more than five separate self-contained dwelling units.

(c) Farm Entranceways

A farm entrance opening onto a Municipal Road from a farm, primarily for access to barns and out-buildings.

Farm: A farm is defined as a holding of arable land of more than 10 acres (4.1 hectares).

(d) Field Entranceways

A field entranceway is an opening onto a Municipal Road from a field forming a part of a farm. It shall be used only for the passage of animals and crops, but not for access to buildings of any type.

(e) Pedestrian Entranceways

A pedestrian entranceway is an entrance opening onto a Municipal Road for the sole use of pedestrians.
